Environmental Policy

At D. Wise Ltd we manufacture and supply a range of pasteurised egg products. We aim to achieve the highest levels of environmental performance within our business and are committed to ensuring we meet our compliance obligations as well as the needs of our customers, employees and stakeholders.

It is to this end that we operate a formal Environmental Management System (EMS) and which is subject to an annual, external inspection by a UKAS Accredited Inspection Body against the Seren Environmental Standard / BS 8555. This gives our stakeholders greater assurance we are fulfilling our public commitments made herein.

The Managing Director is accountable for preventing pollution from our activities, protecting the environment, and fulfilling our compliance obligations, supported by adherence to robust operational controls and monitoring. All staff are required to comply with this Policy and shall be supported through training or other means to embed company-wide collaboration on environmental management and best practices, and to ensure the EMS achieves its intended outcomes. We are committed to the continual improvement of our EMS to enhance environmental performance and to meet the requirements of our Environmental Standard through setting annual improvement objectives associated with our environmental aspects.

We shall:

- Prevent pollution whenever possible and practicable, by the use of non-polluting techniques and practices and monitor environmental trends in best practices
- Improve our management of energy, resources, raw materials and emissions in all activities, including but not limited to, the advancement of carbon reduction initiatives in consideration of climate change, the life cycle consideration of our processes and be mindful of any impacts on biodiversity
- Improve our management of waste through avoidance, minimisation, re-use and recycling foremost before considering other less desirable disposal options
- Inform and educate all persons working for or on behalf of the company to ensure we fulfil our compliance obligations and prevent pollution
- Periodically check our compliance is up-to-date by correspondence with those appropriate external agencies and by checking documentation, and supported by external expertise
- By consulting with our customers at contract, management and service levels
- Communicate with other stakeholders as appropriate
- Regularly monitor our performance and remain adaptable to changing circumstances

We endeavour to supply our EMS to our customers when contractually required. EMS matters are communicated within our organisation through notice boards, meetings and on the company's web site. This policy will be periodically reviewed by the Managing Director, or their representative, within a three year period and be made widely available.
